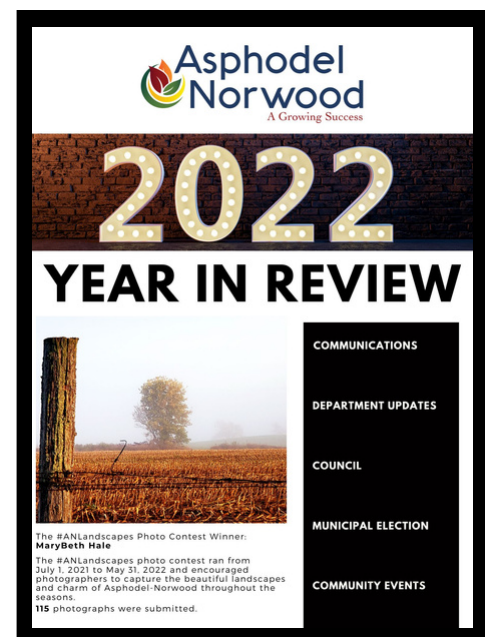


Please enjoy the 2023 first quarter newsletter; covering the months of January, February, and March.

# 2023 Budget



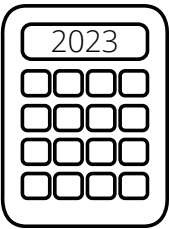
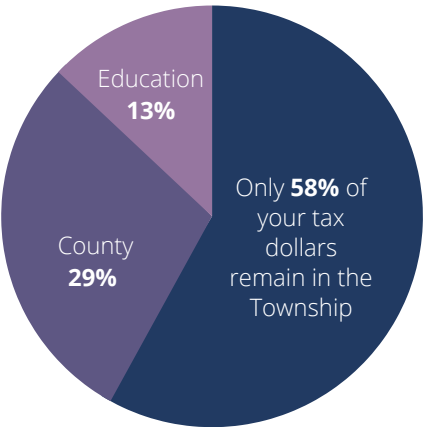
At its regular/public meeting held January 17, 2023, the Council of the Township of Asphodel-Norwood adopted the 2023 municipal budgets:

# Themed Public Skating

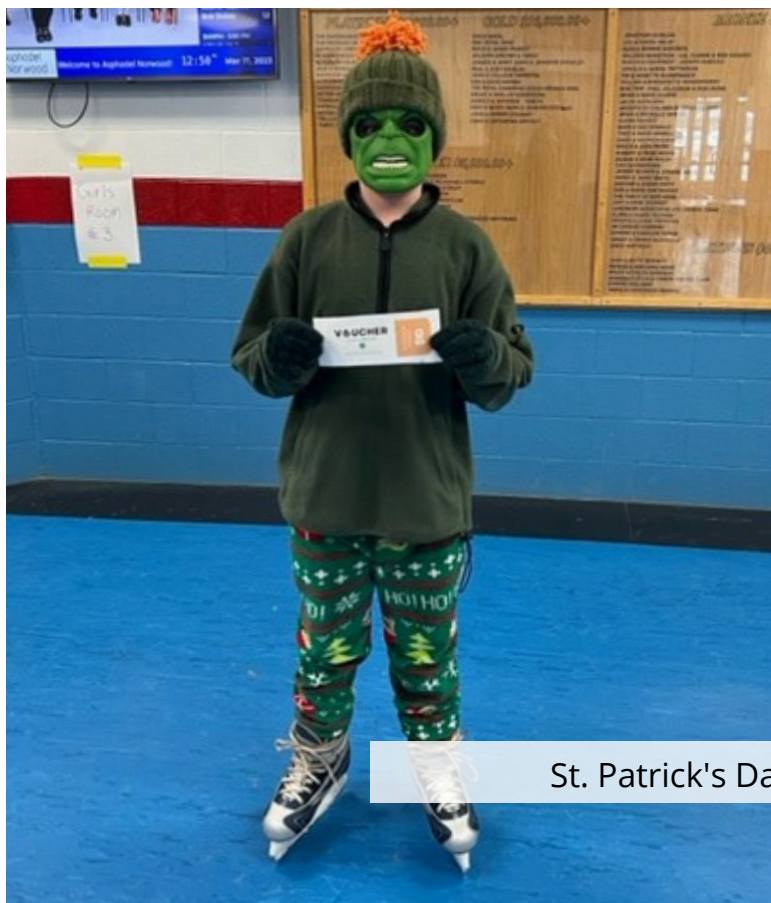
The Township continued to offer themed public skating opportunities this quarter with the incentive of winning one of three \$10 canteen vouchers for participating!

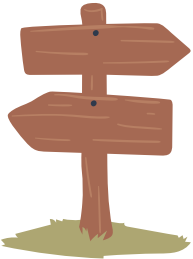
