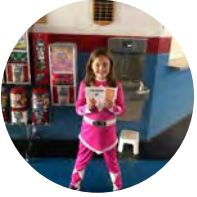

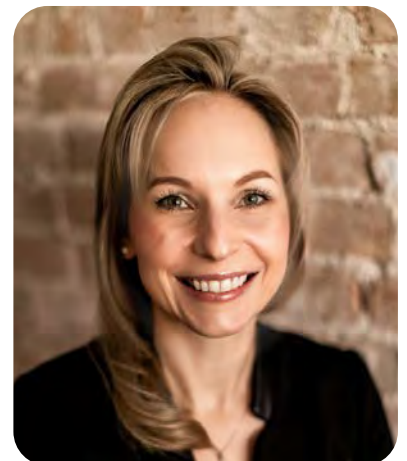

Load the Loader



Time and time again our community comes together to support each other and our annual **Load the Loader** event is a shining example of Asphodel-Norwood's generous spirit!

Many thanks to our Public Works department for collecting food donations on the evening of Tuesday December 5, 2023 in various locations throughout the Township; and thank YOU for the generous donations (including \$120 in cash) to the Asphodel-Norwood Ministerial Food Bank!

Water Standpipe

- In December of 2020 the Township initiated a Municipal Schedule "B" Class Environmental Assessment (EA) to provide treated water storage options for the Village of Norwood for the next 20+ years
- The EA process was completed in February of 2022 with a recommended solution to construct a larger standpipe (approx. 2,300 m³ additional capacity) with an increased hydraulic grade line of approximately 13 m at the location of the current standpipe
- Township staff applied for funding support through the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP) Green stream, strongly advocating for the project with both the provincial and federal levels of governments, and were successful with the application
- Greer Galloway was awarded the RFP for Professional Engineering Services; and Greerario was awarded the project tender for supply and install
- Construction commenced August 2023



The anticipated project completion date is late January 2024 with final grading/topsoil/seeding to be completed in the spring once the existing standpipe is removed

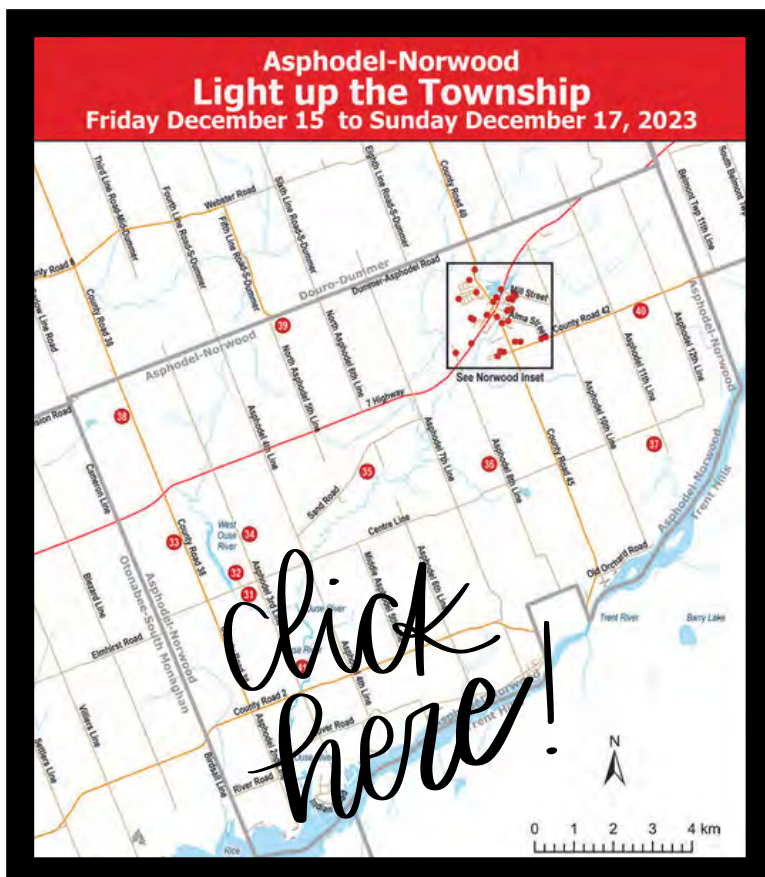


LIGHT UP THE TOWNSHIP TOUR MAP

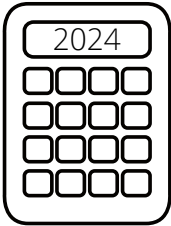
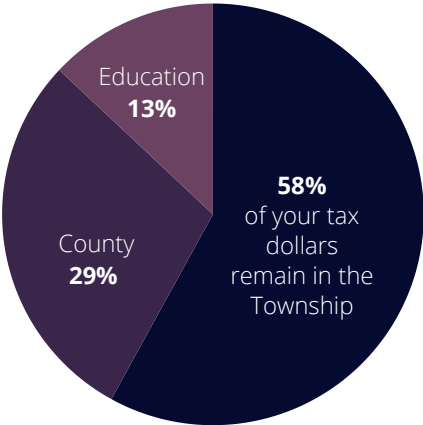
At its regular/public meeting held November 14, 2023, the Council of the Township of Asphodel-Norwood adopted the 2024 municipal budgets:

- 2024 Trentview Estates Distribution System Budget.

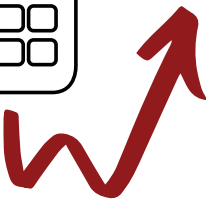
