ASPHODEL PARK

As forecasted in the 2022-2026 Parks and Playgrounds Plan, the playground structure at Asphodel Park (1446 Asphodel 3rd Line) is slated for replacement with the second option (pictured left) chosen by popular vote through a public opinion survey offered in June, 2022. The new structure is expected to arrive in before the 2023 summer season.






ALL-WHEELS SKATE PARK

Through a successful grant application to the Canada Community Revitalization Fund, construction on the All-Wheels skate park commenced the week of September 26, 2022; and thanks to an extended autumn season, approx. 75% of the concrete work was completed. The remaining work, including landscaping and equipment installation will commence in Spring 2023.

FITNESS CENTRE EXPANSION

Made possible through the Investing in Canada Program (ICIP) – Community, Culture and Recreation Stream; construction on the Asphodel-Norwood Fitness Centre (a 3,500 sq foot expansion to the Asphodel-Norwood Community Centre) commenced in the summer of 2022 with the grand opening in March of 2023.







2022 Snowman Building Competition Winner

FAMILY DAY

41 families participated in the 2022 Snowman Building Contest. The Bauman family, pictured above, received the most votes, winning a family meal and dessert from The Knockout/Sweetheart's Bakery as well as toboggans for outdoor play from Norwood Home Hardware.

CANADA DAY

The Township welcomed its first inperson event since 2019 at the Community Centre, with over a 1,000 people in attendance!

EARTH DAY

Staff collected over 100 bags of waste and various items from Township roads. Two (2) maple trees were planted at St. Paul CES and ten (10) new trees were planted throughout the Township in collaboration with the Special Projects committee.

TRAILS DAY

The Trails Committee, in partnership with the Norwood Lions Club, Peterborough County GIS, Fleming College, and Norwood District Intermediate and High School unveiled new trail maps at the Mill Pond Forest Trails on August 6, 2022 for Trails Day.
